




Moodle 4.3 – last October – MDL-76204

- New filtering UI in the question bank and quiz random questions
- Users can customise their view of the question bank
- Question statistics finally usable (thanks UCL & OU also in stables)
- Usability improvements around versioning (still more to do)
- API for question bank actions improved

Currently


- Attempts created synchronously when student clicks 'Start attempt'

- Quiz forum thread




Quiz 4.2 & 4.3 – MDL-74607

• Previously, each quiz gave a single grade


- New option, to have more than one






